An exhibition depicting works of local artists produced during workshops with Brisbane based professional artist Joanne Brooker (Cartoon & Caricature)

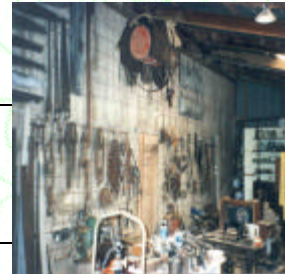


Premier's Multicultural Photograph Awards 17th Feb - 2nd March 2006

An exhibition of Art History shoes, Kangaroo shoes and Food shoes by Townsville based artist Jan Hynes .



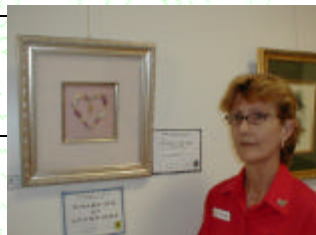
Acquisitive Art Competition 7th- 23rd September 2006
