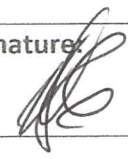

The grounds for our objection to this proposal are:

- risk of fire and/or explosions with unproven new technology,
- fires that cannot be extinguished leading to the possibility of fires igniting in surrounding areas putting stress on limited local firefighting resources,
- toxic fumes from the fire affecting wildlife, livestock and human populations,
- fire water runoff and residue from fires contaminating soil, groundwater and/or surface water, and catchment areas that wildlife, livestock and human population use as water supply,
- pollution from release of refrigerants and coolants and oils during a fire
- noise level concerns from the cooling systems used to cool the large number of containers housing the Tesla batteries.

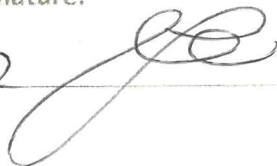
