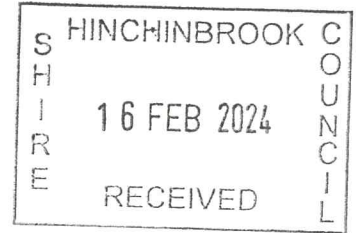

We, the undersigned residents and landowners of Mount Fox and Hinchinbrook Shire, request that Council does not approve the development application reference MCU23/0005, RC23/0016, OPW23/0007 for material change of use for battery storage facility, reconfiguration of lot (creation of a lease/s (in excess of 10 years) and /or Access Easement/s over Lot 592 of SP302249 and Lot 18 WU6 only), and operation work (vegetation clearing). The grounds for our objection to this proposal are:

- risk of fire and/or explosions with unproven new technology,
- fires that cannot be extinguished leading to the possibility of fires igniting in surrounding areas putting stress on limited local firefighting resources,
- toxic fumes from the fire affecting wildlife, livestock and human populations,
- fire water runoff and residue from fires contaminating soil, groundwater and/or surface water, and catchment areas that wildlife, livestock and human population use as water supply,
- pollution from release of refrigerants and coolants and oils during a fire
- noise level concerns from the cooling systems used to cool the large number of containers housing the Tesla batteries.
- Clearing of significant area of land around the battery energy storage system affecting existing wildlife and vegetation
- Clearing of significant land area leading to excess runoff during rain events which will affect turbidity in waterways.
- the proposed use is not consistent with the current land use which is grazing and unimproved land.
- the proposed use is inconsistent with the ethos of the Mt Fox community which consists of graziers and residents who have purchase property in the area to escape the urban environment including noise and air pollution and the effects of electromagnetic radiation,
- the proposal is also inconsistent with existing regulations concerning land clearing and proposes clearing of remnant vegetation in an endangered or in an area of concern in a regional ecosystem.
